What Do We Do?

SexGen York aims to foster an accessible, inclusive, affirming intersectional environment for sexual and gender diversity among students, staff, faculty and community members at York University. We engage in advocacy, education and campaigns, and we support campus services and resources for gender and sexual diversity. We strive for York University to be free from prejudice and discrimination towards sexual and gender diversity as these intersect and interact with oppression in all its forms.

What Does Membership Involve?

SexGen members are expected to attend monthly meetings (usually about 60-90 minutes, with refreshments) and to volunteer where they can, at events and workshops for Trans Day of Remembrance, and Pride@York. You can also get involved in particular campaigns and outreach efforts that fit your interests and abilities, as they arise.

What Do Members Get Out of It?

As well as some fun perks (e.g. participating in Pride Events), members of SexGen get to work with great people on issues that directly affect LGBTQ+ folks at York. Have your voice heard on issues ranging from name and pronoun protocols in the classroom, to safety issues on campus. This flexible commitment also counts towards volunteer hours.
